## Digest 1

(A compilation of emailed homework questions, answered around Tuesday.)

Question. (From a student): How can I access the online homeworks on wileyplus?

Answer. In order to access wileyplus, enter blackboard, click on the Content tab on the left side of the screen, click on the Online Homework 1 folder, then click on Section 1.1. After a few prompts about privacy, there should be a prompt asking for your registration code. After you have entered the registration code (or started a 14 day grace period), you should have full access to wileyplus. From then on, whenever you click on an online homework link in blackboard, the online homework should be accessible.

Question. (From a student): How can I access the online textbook?

Answer. First, do the procedure from the previous question (where you enter your access code in blackboard). Then, in blackboard, click on the Content tab on the left side of the screen, click on the folder named "Hughes-Halett Textbook Online", and click on any listed chapter. The online textbook should now be viewable to you.

**Question.** (From a student): I used my back button and wileyplus got messed up. Can I ever use my back button on wileyplus?

Answer. Generally you should never use your back button in your browser while on wileyplus.

**Question.** (From a student): If I only completed the online homework halfway by the online homework deadline, will I get full credit for the problems I did?

Answer. Yes. As long as you press the Submit button for a question, your response for that question will be recorded. So, if you submitted some correct answers to some questions before the online homework deadline, those responses will receive full credit.

**Question.** (From a student): The textbook doesn't seem to cover what we learned in class today (8/20).

Answer. Limits appear at the end of Chapter 2 in the textbook.
